ANNOUNCEMENTS

Council recognized the following:

- Province has moved to Alert Level 4
- Household Bubbles expanded effective April 30, 2020
- May 24 May 31, 2020 is Tourism Week in our province
- May 24-30, 2020 is Paramedic Services Week across Canada
- Bulk Collection Day is June 1, 2020

Council extended condolences to the family and members of the Canadian Forces Snowbirds on the tragic loss of Captain Jennifer Casey during Operation Inspiration.

EXPENDITURE HIGHLIGHTS

Highlights of Council expenditures included:

- \$1,207.50 and \$1,242.00 for snow clearing callouts in April
- \$1,486.72 for rental and disposal of 4 cylinder containers
- \$2,000 to purchase fireworks from Canadian Heritage grant
- \$11,400 to offset the costs of PADA Summer Recreation/ Beautification Program
- \$5,000 budgeted for the Regatta Committee for equipment repairs and maintenance
- \$20,613,75 (HST included) to the Department of Transportation and Works for 200 tonnes of sand and 50 tonnes of salt
- \$1,733.61 including HST to Sansom Equipment Limited for a maintenance contract on the town's generators
- \$7,012.70 including HST for Street Sweeping/Line Painting Contract

PERMITS

Council approved the following permits:

- Two Accessory Building
- Two Occupancy
- One Quarry

MARINE ATLANTIC FERRY

Mayor Power reported Marine Atlantic announced suspension of the ferry service in Argentia for 2020. This was a tremendous blow to our community and the tourism industry in our region. The Mayor issued a media release advising of the Town's disappointment.

POOL UPDATE

The RFQ for the pool project has closed with 6 bidders in total submitting proposals to the owner advisor. The RFQ evaluation process will be ongoing over the next several weeks and is anticipated to be awarded before the middle of June.

WASTE RECOVERY FACILITY

The Town lobbied with Eastern Waste and the Department of Municipal Affairs and Environment to have the waste recovery facility on Fox Harbour Road reopened. The site reopened on June 2nd. Access to the site will be done alphabetically by surnames. You can find the information on our Town sites or by visiting www.easternwaste.ca. Bagged items will only be accepted in clear bags for identification purposes. Clear bags are not to be used in regular or bulk pickup.





RECERATION FACILITIES

Tennis Courts will reopen in Alert Level 3. Playgrounds and fields will remain closed until further notice. Users are asked to respect the guidelines put in place related to COVID-19 prevention.



TENNIS COURT RULES

DURING COVID -19 PANDEMIC

- Physical distancing must be observed at all times (minimum of 2 meters or 6 feet between individuals).
- 2. Players can not play if exhibiting any signs of illness.
- Avoid touching surfaces including railings, seats, net and posts.
- 4. Tournaments are prohibited.
- 5. Each player should bring their own equipment.
- Server must use own tennis ball (clearly marked), otherwise rally play.
- Players can pass each other balls by using their racquet or foot.
- 8. Gatherings not to exceed provincially approved allowable number
