## **CONTRACTS**

Council awarded the following projects and tenders;

- Management Performance Review for the CAO, Manager of Finance, Manager of Tourism, Marketing & Communications, and the Director of Public Works as outlined in document received from HR Project Partners
- Purchase of a Rescue Unit firefighting vehicle to sole bidder Metalfab Ltd at a total project cost of \$488,750 (cost shared 70/30)
- Construction for the Harbour Drive Storm Sewer Upgrades to M.J. Hickey Construction Ltd. in the amount of \$652,455.92. (Cost shared 80/20).
- Temporary contractual agreement with Provincial Ready Mix for a monetary increase of \$4,000/month to help alleviate fuel surcharge during September, October, and November under the Multi Stream Waste Collection Contract
- Freshwater Outfall Project to the low bidder, Universal Environment Services Ltd. at a cost of \$220,129.55. (Cost shared 80/20).
- Demolition, removal, and disposal of building and property remediation at #1253 Main Road to Edward Collins Contracting Ltd. in the amount of \$14,260.
